



The Return Forward Fact Sheet

Saint Philip has several doors to enter the building across the campus. During the week, the main entry door will continue to be on Richard Allen Drive at the FLAC (Family Life/Administration Center) near the Security Office. However, **on Sunday mornings** ALL doors will be open EXCEPT ones leading into the CHAPEL.

- ~Candler Road – Main Sanctuary Door (*west entry*)
- ~Candler Road – Origen Door (*north entry*)
- ~South -handicap/officer/ministerial staff parking (*south entry*)
- ~Richard Allen-GYM door
- ~Richard Allen-Security Office/Front Desk
- ~Richard Allen-Entry Across from 400 parking lot (*east entry*)

- **Everyone is REQUIRED to wear a mask upon entering the building. Please ensure that your mask covers BOTH your nose AND your mouth AT ALL TIMES.**
- **Everyone will have their temperature checked upon entering the building.**
As long as your temperature is 100.4 or under, you will be advanced to the next station.
- **Cool-Down**
The “cool down area” is reserved for those whose temperatures register above the 100.4 safe zone.
- **Will the sanctuary be the only area open for worship?**
No, the sanctuary, both the floor and balcony as well as the Family Life Administration Center (FLAC) will be available for seating.
- **What if I have to go to the restroom?**
You may go to the restroom at any time during the service.
- **What about “Church School”?**
We will continue to hold Church School” online at 10:00am via Zoom. However, for those who attend the first service and cannot make it home in time, we will provide a small space in Hall B for personal Church School Zoom attendance.
- **What if I have a Medical Emergency?**
Please exit your row and go to the back of the church and an usher will direct you to our Health Ministry Room where someone will assist your medical need.

- **What if I need to go to the bookstore?**

One person in your party will be allowed in the bookstore at a time. You may make your purchase and then exit the building. The bookstore hours will be Monday–Friday 10:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. and Sundays 9:30 a.m.-11:30 a.m. (tentative schedule)

- **Will the kitchen be opened for breakfast?**

At this time, it has been advised NOT to offer food services.

- **Will Risen Generation have service at 8:00 am?**

Risen Generation will continue to have service at 11:15 am ONLINE, however we “encourage you” to bring your child to church at 8:00am along with their phone/tablet/IPAD and headphones they will be able to listen to sermons especially prepared for young people and other activities to also keep them engaged in Worship on the Risen Generation YouTube Channel.

- **Can I go to the altar for prayer?**

At this time, it is preferred that you stand or kneel at your seat. If you have the desire to go the altar for prayer, we asked that you arrive between 7:15am- 7:45am. Please be seated by 7:55am to ensure Worship can start promptly at 8:00am. The prayer rooms will also not be opened until further notice.

- **What if I arrive after Worship begins?**

Due to the new format of worship, should you arrive after worship has begun you will be seated in the back of the sanctuary, the balcony or in the FLAC.

- **What should I wear?**

Saint Philip is currently in Casual Summer attire so please be comfortable.

- **Dismissal**

After the Moment of Meditation, you will be asked to be seated and the congregation will be dismissed by sections. We know you have not seen most of your church family in person in over 17 months, it will be tempting to hold conversations as you pass each other in the corridor. It is our prayer that you will acknowledge each other with a smile or a wave and travel **quietly** directly to your car. If you chose to hold conversations, we encourage you to keep your mask on even while speaking in the parking lot.
